RESOLUTION NO. 41


WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that proposed changes to the City Charter should be processed in an orderly way and reviewed by a broadly representative group of citizens, and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature will convene in January, 1972, and will then consider changes in city charters,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA

1. That an eleven member ad hoc Charter Change Review Committee be immediately established and appointed by the City Council to review proposed changes in the City Charter and make recommendations to Council.
2. That said committee be broadly representative of the community.
3. That Council appoint the chairman at the time it completes appointments to the committee.
4. That it is Council's intention to recommend to the State Legislature such changes in the Charter as Council deems necessary but that it is not Council's intention to undertake a complete revision of the Charter at this time.
5. That the establishment of the committee be publicized and all candidates for appointment submit their applications for consideration by Council to the City Clerk no later than Noon, June 28, 1971.
6. That all citizens be invited to submit written suggestions for Charter changes for the committee's consideration.
7. That the committee hold at least one public hearing for the purpose of receiving written and oral suggestions from the public and city officials.
8. That the committee receive staff support from the City Manager and City Attorney.
9. That the committee complete its work and report to the City Council no later than October 26, 1971.
