RESOLUTION NO. 45

WHEREAS, the City Council of Alexandria indicated by signing an agreement with the State Highway Department that the City of Alexandria would participate in the federal grant program known as TOPICS (Traffic Operation Planning to Increase Capacity and Safety); and,

WHEREAS, the TOPICS consulting firm employed under this program has recommended certain projects for early implementation within the City; and,

WHEREAS, this project could aid in relieving congestion on the City streets and help improve traffic safety; and


WHEREAS, this project for signalization of the intersection of Van Dorn Street and Braddock Road qualifies for these federal and state funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Parking Board has recommended that this intersection be signalized to help promote safety and decrease speeding; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby direct the City Manager to commit the City to their share of this project, approximately \$1305 or 15 per cent of the total cost of \$8700

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Alexandria City Council request that this TOPICS project be undertaken immediately.
