

RESOLUTION NO. 46

WHEREAS, the City Council of Alexandria indicated, by signing an agreement with the State Highway Department, that the City of Alexandria would participate in the federal grant program known as TOPICS (Traffic Operation Planning to Increase Capacity and Safety); and,

WHEREAS, the TOPICS consulting firm employed under this program has recommended projects for early implementation within the City; and,

WHEREAS, certain of these projects could aid in relieving congestion on the City streets and help improve traffic safety; and,

WHEREAS, the project for signalization of the intersection of Braddock Road and Beauregard Street qualifies for these Federal and State funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Parking Board has recommended that a traffic signal be placed at this intersection to help promote safety, decrease speeding and foster good driving habits; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby direct the City Manager to take the necessary actions to commit the City to their share of the project which is approximately \$1380 or 15 percent of the total cost of \$9200.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Alexandria City Council request that this one facet of the TOPICS project be undertaken immediately.
