

WHEREAS, a committee has been chosen to forward to the Educational Policy Committee of the University of Virginia Board of Visitors recommendations of candidates for appointment in 1972 as the Chancellor of George Mason College; and

WHEREAS, all of the Northern Virginia members of the committee that has been chosen by the President of the University to make such recommendations are on the faculty of George Mason College, and none of them is a representative of the jurisdictions served by the College; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria has an interest in the leadership and policies of the College stemming from the facts that many young residents of the City are actual or potential students at the College and that the taxpayers of the City contributed \$495,550 to land acquisition for the College site; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Alexandria wishes to assure that all institutions and agencies that receive appropriated funds from the City are committed to policies of non-discrimination with respect to race, creed, age, sex, and place of birth of their officers, employees and clientele; and


WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the search for the new Chancellor of the College should be enriched by the views of the broadest possible spectrum of the citizens of the communities served by the College;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia, that the President of the University be, and he hereby is, respectfully requested to enlarge the committee he has named to include a representative of the City of Alexandria.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, after consultation with members of City Council, is authorized to recommend the name of a citizen to serve as the City's representative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is requested to forward this resolution to the President of the University of Virginia.
