

RESOLUTION NO. 58

WHEREAS, the Alexandria, Virginia waterfront is an asset to the City with outstanding future development and redevelopment potential; and

WHEREAS, high quality, coordinated development and redevelopment would considerably enhance both the private and public economy of the whole City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a Committee of City Council known as the Waterfront Development Coordinating Committee be established which will review all plans and proposals for new development or redevelopment within the entire waterfront area and submit its recommendations to the City Council prior to action approving or disapproving such plans and proposals;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Waterfront Development Coordinating Committee shall consist of the Mayor, Vice Mayor and the Chairman of the Planning Commission with the Mayor as its Chairman.
