

RESOLUTION NO. 6

WHEREAS, the Alexandria School Board is proceeding with the construction of certain improvements at Cora Kelly School and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria is concerned over whether the plans for said construction make adequate provisions for certain types of facilities which will be of great benefit to the citizens of the area, and,

WHEREAS, to the extent practicable, the City Council of Alexandria is desirous of providing the Cora Kelly community with facilities which will adequately meet their needs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Alexandria does hereby request that the Alexandria School Board consider the advisability of incorporating into the improvement program for Cora Kelly School plans for the immediate construction of a permanent structure which shall be suitable for use as an educational, recreational and general community facility at Cora Kelly School.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receipt of the School Board's recommendation, the City Council of Alexandria will promptly consider any request for additional funding that may be required to implement such recommendation.
