WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria has benefited greatly from the distinguished service of David S. Haddock on the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority since November 6, 1961; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Haddock gave freely and unstintingly of his time as Chairman of the Authority and contributed to the present and future well-being of all Alexandrians; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Haddock provided firm, innovative leadership to the Redevelopment and Housing Authority during a particularly dynamic, challenging period when the overall concept of operation of the Authority changed significantly; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Haddock made lasting contributions not only to specific physical development associated with projects such as Mudtown, Gadsby Phase I and Phase II, Andrew Adkins Homes, and the DIP, but also provided substantial guidance to the Executive Director of the Authority in planning for and implementing new public housing policies and in preparing the City for the more sophisticated types of Federally subsidized housing now available;
