

RESOLUTION NO. 67

WHEREAS, John T. Ticer served with distinction as a member of the Northern Virginia Planning District Commission and its predecessor Commissions from January, 1965 to October, 1971; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ticer served on the Northern Virginia Planning District Commission during its difficult formative period when organizational activities were taking place so that the intent of the Virginia Area Development Act of 1968 could be carried out; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ticer freely provided his management and leadership ability to the Commission so that intergovernmental cooperation on a regional basis could become a reality; and

WHEREAS, all of the citizens of Alexandria now benefit from this improved intergovernmental cooperation in terms of improved efficiency and responsiveness in government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Alexandria extends its sincere appreciation to John T. Ticer for his devoted service to the people of Alexandria and all of Northern Virginia for his service on the Northern Virginia Planning District Commission and its predecessors, the Northern Virginia Planning and Economic Development Commission and the Northern Virginia Regional Planning Commission.
