

RESOLUTION NO. 72

WHEREAS, there now exists a serious traffic congestion problem on that portion of Route 7 in the City of Alexandria between I-95 and the west corporate limits, and

WHEREAS, the development of the Skyline Center and the attendant widening of Route 7 in Fairfax County adjacent to the City will increase the existing congestion, and

WHEREAS, a major cause of the congestion is the inadequate width of Route 7 between I-95 and the west corporate limits together with the grade intersection of Route 7 and Beauregard Street, and

WHEREAS, said Route 7 is a part of the Federal Aid Primary System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Alexandria at its regular meeting on November 23, 1971, that:

1. The Virginia Department of Highways is hereby requested to initiate a project for the widening of Route 7 between I-95 and the west corporate limits, including a grade separation at Beauregard Street and Route 7, and

2. The City agrees to participate in such project under the established procedure for such projects, including the payment of 15% of the project cost.

3. The City Manager is authorized to initiate action with the Virginia Department of Highways for said project and shall transmit a copy of this resolution to the Commissioner of Highways.
