

RESOLUTION NO. 73

WHEREAS, the Alexandria City Council and staff have closely followed the activities of the Fairfax County Planning Commission regarding its Bailey's District Plan; and

WHEREAS, during the presentation of the diverse facets of this plan, the severe impact of the proposed development of the Bailey's District on the City of Alexandria's ability to provide responsive municipal services became readily apparent; and

WHEREAS, it appears from presentations made before the Fairfax County Planning Commission and other Fairfax County agencies that the full extent of this impact has not yet been fully determined; and

WHEREAS, the close proximity of the Bailey's Crossroads projects to Alexandria and Arlington makes it imperative that there be close and continuing cooperation among all concerned jurisdictions to assure adequate planning; and

WHEREAS, Arlington County has officially noted this need for close cooperation for the development of Bailey's District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Alexandria City Council goes on record as supporting this coordinated planning effort, solicits the cooperation of the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors and directs the City Manager, Planning Commission, Planning Staff and Public Works Department to initiate appropriate cooperative efforts with their counterparts in Fairfax and Arlington Counties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to transmit certified copies of this resolution to the Boards of Supervisors of Fairfax and Arlington Counties, the Northern Virginia Planning District Commission, the Transportation Planning Board and the Metropolitan Council of Governments.
