

RESOLUTION NO. 81

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria jointly with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and Arlington County, is cooperating in the Flood Control Project on Four Mile Run, designed to eliminate the present serious flooding condition which exists in Arlandria; and

WHEREAS, the present bridge carrying U.S. #1 Highway across Four Mile Run has been found to be inadequate in waterway capacity and requires reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, said U.S. #1 Highway is a Federal Aid Highway under the State System and is therefore eligible for State aid; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has now reached a point where it is desirable that the State Highway Department, in cooperation with Arlington County and the City of Alexandria, begin to design and prepare for construction of a new bridge carrying said U.S. #1 Highway over Four Mile Run;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, AT ITS REGULAR MEETING ON DECEMBER 28, 1971, THAT:

1. The Virginia Department of Highways is hereby requested to initiate a program for the reconstruction of the bridge carrying U.S. Highway #1 over Four Mile Run, together with the necessary approaches to said bridge.
2. The City Council of Alexandria agrees to participate in this project and to pay its proportionate cost in accordance with statutory formula.
3. The Virginia Department of Highways is hereby requested to coordinate its design with the criteria set by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and with the work proposed to be done by the R.F. & P. Railroad immediately east of said U.S. Highway #1, in order to provide the maximum amount of protection to the Arlandria area and Alexandria.
