

RESOLUTION NO. 87

WHEREAS, the City Council of Alexandria indicated by signing an agreement with the State Highway Department that the City of Alexandria would participate in the Federal grant program known as TOPICS (Traffic Operation Planning to Increase Capacity and Safety); and

WHEREAS, the TOPICS consulting firm employed under this program has recommended projects for early implementation within the City; and

WHEREAS, this project will aid in relieving traffic congestion and help to improve traffic safety by widening Van Dorn Street to two lanes in each directions from a point on Kenmore Avenue to a point south of Taney Avenue, as shown and described in the consultants' report for the Northern Virginia TOPICS Program, Project 10-1 and 10-2; and

WHEREAS, the City's 1971-72 Capital Improvement Budget includes the necessary funding for the City's share of the cost of this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Alexandria City Council requests that this TOPICS project be undertaken immediately.
