

RESOLUTION NO. 9

WHEREAS, on May 12, 1970, the City Council of Alexandria adopted a resolution establishing a Landlord-Tenant Relations Committee to conduct an in-depth study of landlord-tenant relations in Alexandria and to report its findings and recommendations to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the said committee in its report to City Council recognized the need for a continuing study of low income rental housing problems with respect to both single and multi-unit housing; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Alexandria City Council to establish a follow-on committee to conduct an in-depth study of both public and private low income housing problems, with particular emphasis on rental housing.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Alexandria do hereby establish a committee to be made up of four (4) members of the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority; one (1) current resident of public housing; one (1) representative of the housing industry, who shall not be required to be residents of the City of Alexandria; four (4) citizens at large; and one (1) representative of the City Attorney's Office.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said Committee shall convene immediately after its appointment by City Council for the purpose of electing a chairman and commencing to conduct an in-depth study of the problems of public and private, single unit and multi-unit low income housing tenants in particular, and of the housing problems of low income persons generally.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that such Committee shall within one hundred twenty (120) days following its appointment present to City Council a report of its findings, along with such legislative and other recommendations as the said Committee may deem proper for the resolution of such problems as are found to exist.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said Committee shall be authorized and empowered, subject to the approval of City Council, to engage the services of such outside advisers as may be deemed appropriate to provide adequate guidance and direction to said Committee in the discharge of the duties delegated to it herein.
