

RESOLUTION NO. 129

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of June, 1972, the President declared a "major disaster" in the State of Virginia under the provisions of Public Law 606, 91st Congress, and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria, is a public entity within said State;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia that the Office of Emergency Preparedness be and hereby is requested to arrange to have the appropriate Federal Agency perform the following work:

- Remove damaged culvert which was impeding drainage flow in Holmes Run Channel at North Van Dorn Street.
- Remove debris from Holmes Run Channel between North Van Dorn Street and Beauregard Street.
- Dredge Four Mile Run Channel at Mount Vernon Avenue.
- Dredge Four Mile Run Channel at Commonwealth Avenue.

This body certified that, to the best of its knowledge and belief, the requested work is eligible under Public Law 606, 91st Congress, and agrees to (a) provide without cost to the United States the temporary use of all lands, easements and right-of-way necessary for accomplishment of the approved work; and (b) agrees to hold and save the United States free from damages due to the approved work and with respect to debris removal shall indemnify the Federal Government against any claim arising from such removal.
