

RESOLUTION NO. 130

In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 12, b(5) of the Basic Plan of the Commonwealth of Virginia Natural Disaster Assistance Relief Plan, which became law on May 5, 1972, the following resolution is adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED that as a result of severe flooding of many areas of this City during and after the passage of Hurricane Agnes through the area on June 21, 1972, this City Council declares that an emergency existed in the City of Alexandria for the period from about 4:33 p.m. June 21, 1972 until approximately 12:00 a.m. June 26, 1972.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager (Director of Civil Defense), Wayne F. Anderson is authorized and directed to take such action, and to make such applications as may be necessary, to insure that maximum assistance is rendered to the inhabitants of the City of Alexandria by Federal, State and local agencies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Wayne F. Anderson, City Manager, is hereby authorized to execute for, and in behalf of, the City of Alexandria such applications for financial and other assistance as may be necessary to recover costs incurred due to Hurricane Agnes.
