

RESOLUTION NO. 134

WHEREAS, the City Council of Alexandria indicated, by signing an agreement with the State Highway Department, that the City of Alexandria would participate in the federal grant program known as TOPICS (Traffic Operations Program to Increase Capacity and Safety); and,

WHEREAS, the TOPICS consulting firm employed under this program has recommended projects within the City; and,

WHEREAS, certain of these projects could aid in relieving congestion on the City streets and help improve traffic safety; and,

WHEREAS, the project for the widening of Braddock Road from Howard Street to Quaker Lane, the provision of a four-foot concrete walk on the north side of Braddock Road from Howard Street to Early Street and the modification of existing channelization and increase the curb radius at the Howard Street-Braddock Road intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council does hereby direct the City Manager to take the necessary actions to commit the City to their share of the project which is approximately \$93,450, 15 percent of the total cost of \$623,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Alexandria City Council request that this one project which is a part of the TOPICS proposals for the City of Alexandria be undertaken as soon as possible.
