

RESOLUTION NO. 148

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, on March 10, 1971, adopted Resolution No. 16 relating to Council appointments to boards, commissions, authorities and committees and on subsequent occasions amended said resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Council on October 10, 1972, passed Ordinance No. 1811 adding Section 2-47.1 to the City Code, which section relates to the terms of office of Council appointees when appointment is made for an indefinite term; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to make it clear that the provisions of Section 2-47.1 would not prohibit appointees from serving on more than one appointive body at any one time, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

That subsection a. of Section 5 of City Council Resolution No. 16, adopted by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia, on March 10, 1971, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new sentence to read as follows:

The provisions of Section 2-47.1 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, shall not be construed to constitute appointments under the terms of subsection 2(e) of this resolution.
