

RESOLUTION NO. 160

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria Pipe and Drum Band was officially formed in January, 1972; and

WHEREAS, this band consists of 21 volunteer bagpipers and drummers who have given unselfishly of their free time for practice and development; and

WHEREAS, the Alexandria Pipe and Drum Band is the City of Alexandria's official Bicentennial Band, and reflective of the City's history and Scottish tradition; and

WHEREAS, all Alexandrians are proud of the Alexandria Pipe and Drum Band and desire to share this band with the rest of the nation; and

WHEREAS, national exposure will also make others proud of this historic City and its institutions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council and the citizens of Alexandria, Virginia request the inclusion of the Alexandria Pipe and Drum Band in the Presidential Inaugural Parade to be held in the Nation's Capital, Washington, D. C., on January 20, 1973.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution endorsing the appearance of the City of Alexandria Pipe and Drum Band be spread upon the minutes of this City Council meeting and that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Chairman of the Presidential Inaugural Parade.
