

RESOLUTION NO. 172

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, on June 5, 1962, adopted a resolution establishing a Park and Recreation Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, on January 13, 1970, adopted a resolution changing the composition, powers and duties of the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to make further changes in the composition, powers and duties of said Commission; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That Section 3 of a City Council resolution adopted January 13, 1970, relating to the composition of the Park and Recreation Commission, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

The Commission shall consist of nine members, six of which shall be appointed by City Council, two of whom shall be chosen from each of the City's three planning districts; one of which shall be appointed by the Youth Council from its membership; one of which shall be appointed by the School Board from its membership; and one of which shall be appointed by the Planning Commission from its membership. The term of service shall be two years. Chairman shall be chosen by a majority vote of all members of the Commission.


2. That Section 4 of said resolution, relating to certain powers and duties, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

The Commission is hereby authorized to establish temporary citizen study committees, when the Commission deems it desirable, whose purpose will be to explore the recreation needs of the City. Appointments of such committees shall be for specified periods of time, not to exceed one year.

3. That Section 5 of said resolution, relating to Commission meetings, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

The Commission shall meet from time to time with each of the study committees and at least twice each year with the Youth Council.
