WHEREAS, Arthur M. Rector was a long-time resident of the City of Alexandria and served his City ably and well during his tenure as Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, Arthur M. Rector distinguished himself as an employee of the First National Bank of Alexandria having worked in every commercial department of the bank, retiring on February 1, 1967, as a Vice President; and

WHEREAS, Arthur M. Rector served his country overseas during World War II with honor and valor; and

WHEREAS, Arthur M. Rector provided great public service to his City and its citizens as a member of numerous state-wide and local organizations including the Board of Trade, Friendship Fire Company, the Alexandria Kiwanis Club, the Alexandria Hospital Corporation, and the Treasurers Association of Virginia; and

WHEREAS, during the course of his long life in this City became known as a very warm, understanding public-spirited citizen, exhibiting the finest attributes of a public official and bringing credit to himself and his City.
