WHEREAS, Conrad Lee Birney died during the performance of his duties as a member of the Alexandria Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Conrad Lee Birney joined the Police Department on April 4, 1956, and has served his Department faithfully and well, first as a patrolman, and later as a detective assigned to the Youth Bureau; and

WHEREAS, during the course of his career, Detective Birney became known as a fair, sympathetic, and understanding public servant; and

WHEREAS, Detective Birney served his country with honor as a member of the United States Marine Corps; and

WHEREAS, Conrad Lee Birney has brought great credit to himself, to his Department, and to the City through the outstanding performance of his duties.
