WHEREAS, Mr. Morrison was a devoted public servant, having served not only the City of Alexandria but the nation at large as a federal official; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Morrison served with distinction for twelve years as City Planner for the City of Alexandria; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Morrison was the recipient of the Alexandria Jaycees Outstanding City Employee Award in 1966; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Morrison served with distinction as past president of the North Ridge Citizens Association, former member of the Alexandria Animal Welfare League, member of the Senior Citizens Advisory Board and member of the Alexandria Hospital Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council feels that Mr. Morrison was indeed an outstanding public official and community leader, and that his life will continue to be a source of inspiration for all Alexandrians;
