

RESOLUTION NO. 200

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia recognizes the need for expanded park and recreational facilities for the residents of Alexandria; and

WHEREAS, a parcel of land known as the Rolfs Tract located in the neighborhood of Dowden Terrace Subdivision and containing approximately 25.5 acres has been designated by the City Council of Alexandria as a prime location for a public park; and

WHEREAS, the Rolfs Tract has been deemed by the City Council of Alexandria as a high priority expenditure because it will benefit all residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Alexandria has initiated proceedings to acquire the Rolfs Tract through condemnation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Alexandria proceed immediately to acquire the entire Rolfs Tract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that once the proceedings to acquire this property are completed that the City of Alexandria immediately execute plans to make the Rolfs Tract a public park for the use and benefit of all the citizens of Alexandria.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the minutes of this City Council meeting.
