

RESOLUTION NO. 229

WHEREAS, the Alexandria Bicentennial Commission plans a wide ranging program of activity in connection with the Bicentennial of American Independence, including publications, art work, and reproduction of Colonial Era artifacts and medals; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Bicentennial Commission has urged that such items be sold at all Bicentennial centers in Virginia; and

WHEREAS, City Council has found that the proper form for the production and sale of such items in the commercial marketplace is through a non-profit corporation; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

A. That the Alexandria Bicentennial Commission be and the same hereby is authorized to charter a non-profit corporation for the purpose of handling funds, property and saleable merchandise in connection with the Bicentennial celebration.

B. That said non-profit corporation be controlled by a Board of Directors appointed by City Council from the membership of the Alexandria Bicentennial Commission.

C. That the following provisions be adopted as conditions under which said non-profit corporation is to operate:

1. Funds raised by said non-profit corporation shall be used to support Bicentennial activities in the City of Alexandria; and

2. The life of said non-profit corporation shall terminate no later than at the end of the Bicentennial celebration, as fixed by law; and

3. Any assets of said non-profit corporation remaining at the date of its dissolution shall revert to the City of Alexandria.

D. That the City shall provide all necessary services for the non-profit corporation.

E. This resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
