

RESOLUTION NO. 231

WHEREAS, the City Council of Alexandria has designated promotion of tourism as one of its goals; and

WHEREAS, the Bicentennial offers a major opportunity for increases in tourism; and

WHEREAS, City Council approved funds in the current fiscal year for the Alexandria Tourist Council to produce a Bicentennial film; and

WHEREAS, Federal funds are available through the Virginia Independence Bicentennial Commission to supplement local funds in the production of a Bicentennial film.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Alexandria approves a joint application by the Alexandria Bicentennial Commission and the Alexandria Tourist Council for grant funds to match City funds already approved, and urges completion of the film project before July 1, 1974.
