

RESOLUTION NO. 246

WHEREAS, the United States District Court has ordered the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority to provide facilities for the handicapped in Metro stations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria, Virginia is a member of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, the cost for these facilities for the handicapped will increase the total Metro system cost by \$65,000,000, the Virginia share of the system cost by \$3,692,000, and the Alexandria share of the Virginia cost by \$715,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, will make its best effort to obtain the necessary funds for the City's share of the cost for the facilities for the handicapped in Metro stations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting of the City Council, and that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority.
