

RESOLUTION NO. 261

WHEREAS, on November 29, 1973, the Reverend Monsignor Martin T. Quinn will retire after almost half a century as a priest, the last 27 years as pastor at Blessed Sacrament Church; and

WHEREAS, Monsignor Quinn was the founder of Blessed Sacrament Church in 1946 and of Blessed Sacrament School in 1949; and

WHEREAS, Monsignor Quinn previously served in the City as pastor at St. Mary's Church from 1926 to 1929, his first assignment following his ordination as a priest in his native Ireland; and

WHEREAS, during these periods of time Monsignor Quinn has served not only his parishioners but the entire City through his dedication to community activities; and

WHEREAS, Monsignor Quinn has been particularly active in his support for ALIVE, Incorporated, a non-denominational Social Service agency in the City which provides assistance to persons in need of help.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, wishes to express its appreciation to the Reverend Monsignor Martin T. Quinn for his many years of service to the citizens of Alexandria upon this the occasion of his retirement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting and that a copy of this resolution be delivered to Monsignor Quinn.
