

RESOLUTION NO. 263

WHEREAS, the City owns or controls all of the land in the City of Alexandria served by the existing Linnean Street overpass; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to relocate Cameron Run parallel to the Beltway; and

WHEREAS, WMATA plans to build its S & I yard over part of existing Cameron Run; and

WHEREAS, the City has approved the permanent closing of Linnean Street at the South City limits on January 1, 1974; and

WHEREAS, the existing overpass is no longer needed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA THAT:

1. The State is requested to remove its Linnean Street overpass over the Beltway as soon after January 1, 1974, as possible.
2. The State transfer title to the City of all of its land within the City limits 150 feet from the centerline of the Beltway now used for Linnean Street and existing Cameron Run, as shown on the attached drawings.
3. The City agrees in return to give WMATA the surface land rights to as much of this land as they need for their proposed S & I yard.
4. The City agrees that it shall keep the remaining surface area for use as Eisenhower Avenue right-of-way and the relocation of Cameron Run.
