

RESOLUTION NO. 266

WHEREAS, local governments are seeking to expend their limited resources on more efficient means of transportation in urban areas; and,

WHEREAS, increasing concern for protection of environmental quality has resulted in new standards for transportation; and,

WHEREAS, population growth in urban areas has reduced the efficiency of the private auto for commuting use; and,

WHEREAS, local governments are aware of the need for regional, state and Federal cooperation in solving transportation problems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Alexandria commends the Arlington County Board for its decision to support a public transportation alternative in the I-66 Corridor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Alexandria supports the Arlington County Board in the view that local, regional, State and Federal agencies should join together in planning for better public transportation.
