WHEREAS, the City Manager needs authorization to apply for and on behalf of the City of Alexandria to the Federal Water Pollution Control Administration, Department of the Interior of the United States of America for the grant of Federal funds for the construction of sewage treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Water Pollution Control Administration, Department of the Interior of the United States of America and its successor, the Environmental Protection Agency, require that a resolution authorizing signatures on applications for Federal funds specify the name of the individual or individuals so authorized to sign such applications; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria desires to install retention and pump back facilities on 3 of its largest combined sewer outfalls which are eligible for said matching funds.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA:

That the City Manager, Wayne F. Anderson, and the Director of Public Works, Dayton L. Cook, are each hereby authorized to execute and file applications on behalf of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, with the Environmental Protection Agency, United States of America, for grants to aid in financing the construction of waste water (sewage) treatment, works and facilities under the provisions of Public Law 660 - 84th Congress, as amended, and the said Wayne F. Anderson and Dayton L. Cook are each authorized to execute any documents required as a condition for consideration of such applications or which may be appended as an exhibit to an application for the grant of such Federal funds.
