

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency of the United States has established regulations for bicycle lane-bicycle rack strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency is requiring the Commonwealth of Virginia, for its portion of the National Capital Interstate Air Quality Control Region, to submit on or before June 1, 1974, a comprehensive study of a bicycle lane network, which shall include a bicycle user and potential user survey, and a determination of the feasibility and location of various methods of safe and secure bicycle parking; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Air Pollution Control Board, as the representative of the Commonwealth of Virginia, will coordinate the bicycle lane networks within its various governmental subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria supports the efforts of the Virginia Air Pollution Control Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED  
BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA  
AS FOLLOWS:

1. That there be established a Committee on Bicycle Lanes and Bicycle Storage Facilities to aid the Virginia Air Pollution Control Board in meeting its deadlines and develop Alexandria's part of the overall plan.
2. That the Committee shall include:
  - (a) One representative of the Traffic and Parking Board
  - (b) One representative of the Environmental Policy Commission
  - (c) One representative of the Planning Commission
  - (d) One member experienced in parking lot/garage operation  
To be nominated by the Chamber of Commerce
  - (e) Three citizen members
  - (f) The City Manager or his designee
  - (g) The Public Works Director
  - (h) The Traffic Director
  - (i) The Planning and Community Development Director
  - (j) The General Services Director
  - (k) The Environmental Health Supervisor
  - (l) One of Alexandria's representatives on the Northern Virginia Planning District Commission
3. That the establishment of the Committee be publicized and all candidates for appointment submit their applications to the City Clerk by the close of business February 5, 1974, for consideration by the City Council and appointment at the first Regular Meeting in February.
4. That the Mayor shall name the convener of the Committee and the Committee shall elect its own chairman and vice chairman.
5. That the Committee may adopt its own rules of procedure, provided that these rules are not in conflict with the provisions of this resolution.
6. The Committee shall report to Council by April 1, 1974, its recommendations for the Alexandria section of the Virginia comprehensive study and a timetable for submission of such subsequent reports and recommendations as shall be required under Environmental Protection Agency rules.
