

WHEREAS, this City Council recognizes the importance of manpower development programs for the well being of the participants in the City's labor market as well as the local business community; and

WHEREAS, as an indication of this recognition, City Council appointed the Mayor's Manpower Advisory Committee in November of 1972; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Manpower Advisory Committee has been attempting to seek solutions to the City's manpower problems; and

WHEREAS, special revenue sharing for manpower development has been looked upon as one vehicle by which the City can address its manpower needs; and

WHEREAS, The President of the United States has recently signed into law the legislation authorizing manpower revenue sharing, officially titled the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Alexandria hereby declares its intent to seek prime sponsorship for funding under the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council instructs the City Manager to convey a copy of this resolution along with any other appropriate documentation to the Department of Labor; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.
