WHEREAS, Mrs. Hubbard served on the Traffic and Parking Board with great distinction, leading the Board in the study and solution of numerous traffic problems and in the public safety efforts of the City's Highway Safety Commission, on which she served as Chairman from April 16, 1973 through January 22, 1974; and
