

WHEREAS, Ada Espenshade Wrigley has made application to correct the 1970 real estate assessment of the City of Alexandria as applied to a certain lot in the City known as Lot 50, Block 1A, Real Estate Assessment Map 221, located at 3001 Old Dominion Boulevard, and for refund in the amount of \$16.92; and

WHEREAS, Section 58-1142 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, provides for the correction of such an erroneous assessment and refund; and

WHEREAS, the Real Estate Assessor for the City of Alexandria, Virginia, has corrected the assessment and certified such correction to the Director of Finance; and

WHEREAS, said Assessor has also presented a certificate to the City Council setting forth facts and stating that such assessment was erroneous; and

OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:




CERTIFICATE

I, Joseph E. Hunt, Director of Real Estate Assessments for the City of Alexandria, Virginia, on this ____ day of January 1974, do hereby certify that Ada Espenshade Wrigley was erroneously assessed in connection with the 1970 real estate tax on a parcel of land identified as Lot 50, Block 1A, Real Estate Assessment Map No. 221, located at 3001 Old Dominion Boulevard, in the City of Alexandria, resulting in an overcharge of \$16.92. The erroneous assessment was made upon a recorded lot size of 10,647 square feet, but a resurvey has shown the lot to contain only 8,714 square feet. Ada Espenshade Wrigley has paid the total assessment and made timely application for refund of the overcharge.
