WHEREAS, William B. Hurd has served with great distinction as a member of the Alexandria School Board since his initial appointment on June 24, 1969; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria has benefitted greatly from Mr. Hurd's five years of service on the School Board, the last two of which he has served as its distinguished Chairman; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hurd's service on the Alexandria School Board covered a period of major social and educational challenges to which the Board made positive, progressive responses in order to provide the students of Alexandria with the highest possible quality of education; and
