

RESOLUTION NO. 346

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to recognize in an appropriate manner those individuals who make extraordinary contributions to the City and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the efforts and activities of Mrs. Louise W. Wainwright have had a profound beneficial effect upon the lives of the residents of Cameron Valley; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Wainwright began working for the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority in 1968 as a Maintenance Aide and rose to the position of Assistant Social Services Director before her retirement in 1974; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Wainwright spent endless hours working with the tenants of Cameron Valley, assisting them to obtain meaningful employment, counselling with them on personal problems, and assuring that needed social services were available either through City or private agencies; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Wainwright was instrumental in organizing the Cameron Valley Mothers Club, and the range of her activities spanned from planning and sponsoring the Cameron Valley Sociables Senior Citizens Club to organizing and coordinating numerous youth activities and programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the new swimming pool in Cameron Valley shall be named the "Louise W. Wainwright Pool" in recognition of Mrs. Wainwright's contributions to the residents of Cameron Valley and the City of Alexandria.
