

RESOLUTION NO. 347

WHEREAS, certain citizens have given special, extraordinary and superior service to the City of Alexandria and its Bicentennial effort; and

WHEREAS, requirements for service on the City's Bicentennial Commission may preclude appointment of such individuals to the regular Bicentennial Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Alexandria Bicentennial Commission has unanimously requested authority to recognize such individuals by the virtue of their service to the City and its Bicentennial effort.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Alexandria that the Alexandria Bicentennial Commission shall have the authority to nominate for City Council appointment honorary members to not more than two persons in each calendar year for services rendered to the Bicentennial cause, and that in such action the Commission shall have the full backing of the City Council. Such honorary members shall have full rights of attendance at Bicentennial events and Commission meetings and rights of discussion at such meetings but shall not be permitted to vote on the expenditure of funds or on substantive positions taken by the Commission on matters of policy.
