

RESOLUTION NO. 430

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, has been advised that the Commonwealth of Virginia may not provide full funding for the 1976-78 biennium for open space, park and recreation needs as proposed by the Virginia Commission of Outdoor Recreation, and

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to acquire, preserve and develop limited open space areas for future public uses, and

WHEREAS, only through maximum Federal, State and local participation can the necessary financial resources be obtained to provide for the public's interest in park, recreation and open space programs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, calls upon the Governor and the General Assembly to provide for State funding at the level of \$23.6 million, supplementing the estimated \$7 million of Land and Water Conservation Funds, as proposed by the Virginia Commission of Outdoor Recreation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be sent to the Governor, the Northern Virginia representatives of the Virginia Senate and House of Delegates, the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority, other Northern Virginia local governing bodies, and to the Virginia Municipal League.
