

RESOLUTION NO. 444

WHEREAS, on May 27, 1969, the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia, established by resolution an eleven member citizens advisory committee known as the Bi-Centennial Commission, the purpose of which is to cooperate with similar regional state and national groups and to prepare recommendations for City Council regarding appropriate ceremonies, affairs and observances to be held in the City of Alexandria in recognition of the 200th anniversary of the independence of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, on December 10, 1969, the City Council increased, by resolution, the number of citizen members on said Commission to twelve; and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 1971, the City Council increased, by resolution, the number of citizen members on the Commission to thirteen, one of which shall belong to a patriotic organization; and

WHEREAS, on May 28, 1974, the City Council further increased, by resolution, the number of citizen members to seventeen to assure that diverse elements of the Alexandria community have an opportunity to participate; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to provide the full voting membership for a young person.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE
CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA

That the fifth paragraph of the Council resolution of May 27, 1969, amended on December 10, 1969, on January 12, 1971, and on May 28, 1974, be further amended to read as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Members of City Council of Alexandria, Virginia, that there is hereby established an eighteen member citizens (one of whom shall belong to a patriotic organization and one of whom shall be under the age of 18) advisory commission to be known as the Bi-Centennial Commission whose purpose shall be to cooperate with similar regional, state and national groups and in the preparation of recommendations to City Council for appropriate ceremonies, affairs and observances to be held in the City of Alexandria in recognition of the bi-centennial anniversary of the independence of the United States of America, with the addition of the Mayor and Members of City Council with Ex-officio members of the Commission.
