

RESOLUTION NO. 456

WHEREAS, Section 4.05 of the City Charter provides that in the event of the temporary absence or disability of the city manager, the city council may by resolution appoint a person to perform the duties of the city manager until said manager returns to duty; and

WHEREAS, the city manager will on occasion be temporarily absent from the city on business or on vacation or may on other occasions be temporarily disabled due to illness; and

WHEREAS, the city council wishes to provide for such eventualities so that there will always be available in the city some person with authority to perform the duties of city manager; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That Clifford Rusch, be and he hereby is appointed to perform the duties of city manager of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, during any temporary absence from the city or disability of the city manager until the city manager returns to duty.

2. That James Randall, and in the event of his absence Dayton L. Cook, be and they hereby are appointed to perform the duties of city manager during any temporary absence or disability of Clifford Rusch, until Clifford Rusch returns to duty.

3. This resolution shall take effect January 13, 1976.
