

RESOLUTION NO. 460

WHEREAS, Wiley F. Mitchell, Jr., a member of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, resigned from his position as a member of the Council on January 13, 1976; and

WHEREAS, a vacancy in the membership of said Council now exists; and

WHEREAS, said vacancy has occurred within one hundred eighty days of the next ensuing regular council election scheduled for May 4, 1976; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable as soon as practicable to fill said vacancy for the unexpired term.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That it is hereby certified to the senior Judge of the Circuit Court of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, (formerly the Corporation Court of said City) that a vacancy in the membership of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, exists and that such vacancy occurred within one hundred eighty days of the next ensuing regular council election scheduled for May 4, 1976.
2. That pursuant to the City Charter (Section 10.02, Chapter 166, Acts of Special Session of the General Assembly of Virginia of 1971) it is hereby requested that said vacancy be filled for the unexpired term by appointment by the senior Judge of the Circuit Court of the City of Alexandria.
3. That a copy of this resolution, signed by the Mayor and attested by the Clerk of the Council, be delivered to the senior Judge of the Circuit Court of the City of Alexandria, so that an appointment may be made in the manner provided for by law.
