

RESOLUTION NO. 473

WHEREAS, the Advisory Commission on Aging was created by the City Council in Resolution No. 62 adopted on September 27, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the City Council changed the name of said Commission to Commission on Aging and amplified Resolution No. 62 in Resolution No. 443 adopted on November 25, 1975; and

WHEREAS, the membership of the Commission on Aging consists of nine members appointed at large and six ex officio members representing designated groups and organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has recommended to Council that in the event any designated group or organization fails to nominate a candidate for a vacancy reserved to it, Council should appoint a citizen-at-large to such ex officio position; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that Resolution No. 443 should be amended to implement the Commission's recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

That Part 1 of the paragraph beginning "The organization and membership of the Commission on Aging shall be as follows" on page 2 of the resolution numbered 443, adopted by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia, on November 25, 1975, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subpart d. to read as follows:

d. Any vacancy in the ex officio membership provided for in b. above may be filled by a citizen-at-large in the event Council is unable to appoint an ex officio member from a designated group or organization for a period of sixty (60) days after first advertising the vacancy when said inability to appoint is the result of the failure of any such designated group or organization to nominate a candidate for the vacancy. Any citizen-at-large appointed to such a vacancy shall be an ex officio member of the Commission.
