

RESOLUTION NO. 529

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a request by resolution be made to the Department of Highways and Transportation of the Commonwealth of Virginia by the City Council of the City of Alexandria for each project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, at its regular meeting on this 11th day of January, 1977, that:

(1) The Virginia Department of Highways and Transportation be, and hereby is, requested to establish a project within the City of Alexandria, Virginia, for the design and construction of a computerized traffic signal for the Central Business District, Jefferson Davis Highway, Duke Street, and Van Dorn Street, as shown on the map, dated August 5, 1976, with provisions for future addition of signals for such other areas as may be designated.

(2) That the City hereby agrees to pay its share of the cost for preliminary engineering, right of way, and construction under the cost formula of 85 percent by the Virginia Department of Highways and Transportation and 15 percent by the City.

(3) That the system after installation will be 100% owned and operated by and under the control of the City of Alexandria and therefore the City shall provide 100% of the cost of said operation.

(4) The City further agrees that if the said project is established as herein requested and thereafter the said City decides not to proceed further with the said project, then the City, by this resolution, agrees to repay the Virginia Department of Highways and Transportation for 100 percent of the cost incurred for the said project to the time of the action of the City causing work to be stopped on the project.
