

RESOLUTION NO. 530

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, on June 27, 1974, adopted Resolution No. 331 creating a Transportation Planning Board to advise City Council on various long-range and short-range transportation plans; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, on January 13, 1976, adopted Resolution No. 458 amending Resolution No. 331 with respect to certain functions of the Transportation Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, the composition of the Transportation Planning Board includes a representative of the city's Planning Advisory Committee which committee has been discharged by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the discharge of the Planning Advisory Committee has created a vacancy on the Transportation Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Planning Board has recommended and the City Council desires to make a change in the composition of the board by amending Resolutions No. 331 and 458;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE  
CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That all references to the "Planning Advisory Committee" in Resolutions No. 331 and 458 be and the same hereby are deleted.

2. That paragraphs 1 and 2 of the second Resolve Clause in Resolution No. 331 be and the same hereby are amended to read as follows:

1. One member each of, and nominated respectively by, the Planning Commission and the Traffic and Parking Board who shall serve on the board coextensively with their terms on their parent body, and

2. Five citizen members, at least one of whom shall be knowledgeable in the field of air quality and air pollution abatement, who shall serve a term of three years, except that:

(a) Initially as decided by lot one citizen member shall serve a term of one year, and one citizen member shall serve a term of two years, and

(b) Any appointment to fill a vacancy shall be for the duration of the unexpired term.
