

RESOLUTION NO. 537

WHEREAS, the Alexandria City Council is concerned about the condition of the Alexandria City Jail Facility, and

WHEREAS, the City Council is in favor of upgrading the jail to provide a humane adult detention facility, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received an architect's study containing recommendations for improvement of the facility, and

WHEREAS, the implementation of such recommendations would improve the condition of the facility,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in order to provide for a humane jail facility, the Council will consider the funding of the improvements for the jail recommended in the architect's study as a priority item in the City's FY 1977-78 Capital Budget.
