

RESOLUTION NO. 549

WHEREAS, a number of City public housing residents in the John Roberts Homes must be relocated as a result of METRO construction, and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria desires to relocate these residents to other housing in the City, and

WHEREAS, three sites have been identified for the development of replacement housing by ARHA, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to use City-owned property adjacent to the William Ramsey School for one of the sites for this housing, and

WHEREAS, the City intends to transfer the City-owned property to the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority in order that ARHA can proceed with development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Alexandria City Council intends to transfer by donation to the Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority the City-owned property adjacent to the William Ramsey School in order that it may be used for the development of replacement housing for a portion of the public housing at John Roberts Homes which is to be demolished for planned METRO construction. This resolution is an expression of intent only and is not to be construed as a legal action effecting such transfer.
