

RESOLUTION NO. 554

WHEREAS the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia has requested the State of Virginia to reevaluate its plans for the Route 1 corridor and;

WHEREAS the State of Virginia has agreed to review its proposed plans for the Route 1 Corridor and;

WHEREAS the State wishes to know how the City now feels about the several different possible projects in the Route 1 Corridor;

THEREFORE the City Council hereby wishes to denote its general feelings on these projects:

THE CITY COUNCIL Of the City of Alexandria is opposed to:

1. The relocation of Route 1 south of the Monroe Avenue bridge.
2. The replacement of the Monroe Avenue bridge with a six-lane bridge.
3. The widening of Jefferson Davis Highway to six lanes from a point 100 ft. north of Reed Ave. southward.
4. The Potomac Expressway.
5. The Northeast Expressway.
6. Any Commonwealth Avenue-Eads Street connection.
7. Any widening of Reed Avenue.

THE CITY COUNCIL does support:

1. A new four-lane Monroe Street bridge, equivalent in traffic carrying capacity to the existing bridge.
2. The computerized signal system, as previously approved by the City Council.

THEREFORE this resolution has been adopted by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia and the foregoing shall be considered to be the policy of the City of Alexandria as it relates to the Route 1 Corridor until and unless a resolution to the contrary shall be adopted by this or subsequent City Councils of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.
