

RESOLUTION NO. 557

WHEREAS, it appears that a substantial amount of taxes lawfully imposed pursuant to ordinances of the City of Alexandria, Virginia have not been paid and are due and owing to the City and are therefore delinquent; and

WHEREAS, these unpaid taxes constitute a significant loss of revenue to the city, and an inequitable distribution of the tax burden between those citizens subject to taxation who pay their taxes and those who do not;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

The city attorney is hereby authorized and directed to pursue any legal remedies that are available for the collection of taxes which are owed to the City of Alexandria, Virginia and are delinquent, including motions for judgment, as shall be deemed by him to be advisable and expedient.
