

RESOLUTION NO. 561

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, is of the opinion that members of authorities, boards, commissions and committees of the city perform valuable service to the City of Alexandria; and

WHEREAS, the city council greatly values and appreciates the contributions made to the community by the members of such authorities, boards, commissions and committees; and

WHEREAS, the city council recognizes that many qualified and able residents of the city volunteer to serve on such authorities, boards, commissions and committees; and

WHEREAS, the city council believes it important that many residents of the city be given an opportunity to serve their community as members of such authorities, boards, commissions and committees; and

WHEREAS, the city council is of the opinion that the city and its authorities, boards, commissions and committees benefit by new insights brought to community concerns as new members are appointed; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

1. That no person shall be eligible to serve on any one authority, board, commission or committee of the city more than two successive full terms; provided that after having served two successive full terms on any authority, board, commission or committee, persons may again be appointed to serve on such authority, board, commission or committee following one intervening year.
2. That the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution shall apply to all authorities, boards, commissions and committees of the city unless otherwise provided by law.
3. That city council shall not under any circumstances waive the requirements of Section 1 of this resolution.
4. This resolution shall become effective July 1, 1977.
