

RESOLUTION NO. 565

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Intergovernmental Affairs (Office of Human Resources) provides support from the Urban Assistance Incentive Fund to assist political subdivisions of the Commonwealth of Virginia in preventing neighborhood deterioration; and

WHEREAS, there are neighborhoods within the City of Alexandria with urgent needs to prevent such deterioration; and

WHEREAS, a combination of public and private non-profit agencies in this city have developed a program labeled "Project ACT" to prevent or restore housing deterioration in the Mount Jefferson district (Census Tract 2012.01); and

WHEREAS, this program would serve as a model for other cities facing similar problems,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to prepare and transmit to the Department of Intergovernmental Affairs such information as may be necessary to meet final review of eligibility and funding for Project ACT.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Council of the City of Alexandria as governing body gives its assurance that local matching funds for the Project's cost up to \$4,060 are available and will be provided.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City of Alexandria will provide adequate accounting facilities to the Project.

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Alexandria will abide by all applicable State and federal regulations governing such expenditure of funds provided by the Virginia Department of Intergovernmental Affairs,

AND, ALSO, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Virginia Department of Intergovernmental Affairs is respectfully requested to assist in the prompt approval and funding of Project ACT in order to provide the preventive maintenance skills and prevent the deterioration of housing which Project ACT envisages.
